



## Celebrate Bugs

Going on a bug hunt...what will we find?  
Big bugs! Little bugs!  
God made all kinds!

Bugs, bugs and more bugs----let's talk about bugs! The big word is **exoskeleton**. We have bones, but the bug is protected by its exoskeleton (skeleton on the outside). That hard covering, the exoskeleton, protects the insect from drying out and gives it shape. Most insects **molt**--as they grow, the outside covering splits to let the insect wiggle out. The bigger exoskeleton dries and hardens on the insect's exterior. Learn "All About Bugs" - <https://youtu.be/rKQfJFAHW8Q> God thought of everything - he even created protection for the bugs! Notice the detail of the bugs body (Remember it is best to stay far way from insects that may sting!) Draw a jar and use fingerprints (ink or paint) to make bugs. When the paint is dry, use a black pen or marker to create your bugs. God made each bug unique! *"And God made...everything that creeps upon the ground according to its kind. ### Insect Snacks:

**Ants on a log snack**—you need celery sticks, raisins, peanut butter or cream cheese, or hummus. Fill celery sticks with your choice of peanut butter or cream cheese or hummus. Add raisins on the top to represent ants walking on a log.



Use other fruits and veggies to make other insects. Eat and enjoy. Round crackers, cream cheese, black olives and grape tomatoes cut in half. Lady bug snack!
